Voiceless sounds are pronounced with /t/
(p -s -sh - ch- f- p - k -x)
Ex: cook<u>ed</u> = /kokt/
Fix<u>ed</u> = /fixt/

Voice sounds are pronounced with /d/ (m-r-n-l-b-v-z- y-g-w) Ex: call**ed**= /kold/ clos**ed** = /klozd/

Verbs with t or d as a final sound are pronounced as /id/
Ex: waited = /wetid/
Needed = /nidid/
