

Pronunciation of Regular Verbs

Voiceless sounds are pronounced with /t/
(p -s -sh - ch- f- p - k -x)
Ex: cooked = /kɒkt/
Fixed = /fɪxt/

Voice sounds are pronounced with /d/
(m-r-n-l-b-v-z- y-g-w)
Ex: called = /kɒld/
closeed = /kloʊzd/

Verbs with t or d as a final sound are pronounced as /ɪd/
Ex: waited = /weɪtɪd/
Needed = /niːdɪd/
